Who we are

Healing Spaces provides gentle, in-home wellbeing support and decluttering for adults in West London. The founder, Karina (Kari) Barboza, spent several years as an NHS Lived Experience Professional and a Peer Trainer at the West London NHS Trust Recovery College, and brings lived experience, trauma-informed training, and bilingual support (English and Spanish) to every visit. We offer a free first visit so people can assess fit without pressure.

We are a practical, calm, judgement-free service. We are not a crisis or clinical service, but we often help where someone is stuck, ashamed, and needs supportive, consensual, practical help at home.

Who this is for

Adults in Ealing, Hounslow, Hammersmith and nearby West London (within about an hour of W13) who are:

- struggling with self-neglect or a home that has become overwhelming
- living with hoarding patterns and at risk of tenancy, health, or safety problems
- ADHD, autistic, or otherwise neurodivergent and stuck with executive-function and clutter
- recovering from a mental-health crisis and returning to a home environment that threatens relapse
- in need of calm, paced, non-judgemental home support that clinical services do not provide

What we do, and what we do not do

We do: work alongside the person, at their pace, with full consent at every step; sort, declutter, and organise; set up simple systems that last; arrange donation, disposal, or storage as agreed; and hold a warm, shame-free space.

We do not: force, rush, or remove anything without consent; provide clinical treatment, therapy, or crisis intervention; or work where a person is in active crisis. We cannot begin or continue practical work while someone is experiencing active psychosis, is in an acute mental-health crisis, or is temporarily unable to engage safely and give meaningful consent; a diagnosis alone does not automatically exclude someone from using the service. Where a safeguarding concern about an adult at risk arises, safety and the correct escalation come first, ahead of any decluttering work.

The free first visit

A link worker, clinician, housing officer, or family member can hand someone one thing: a **free, judgement-free first visit**. No commitment, no cost, no need to tidy first. It is the lowest-risk way to help someone take the first step.

How to refer

- Share our details and the free-first-visit offer with the person, or contact us directly with their consent.
- Our intake asks "how did you hear about us?" so we can keep referrers updated on outcomes (with client consent).
- We are happy to provide feedback to referrers, with the client's consent.

Pricing

Every client gets a **free first visit**. After that, transparent **per-session** pricing with structured half-day and ongoing-support options; the always-current price list is at **healing-spaces-kari.co.uk/pricing**. We offer a **discounted community partnership rate** for clients referred via NHS, Recovery College, charity, or council routes. Eligible employed or self-employed clients may be able to fund appropriate workplace-related support through the **DWP Access to Work** scheme, and we can provide the quotations and invoices an application requires.
